Introduction to Beekeeping Course 2021

This course will be led by Rob Nickless (a local bee farmer) and will comprise one session a week over six weeks during January and February 2021; and, if arrangements can be made for a venue, a practical two session hive building course during February may take place.

Due to the current COVID-19 restrictions our 2021 course will be held as an online course and participants will be able to attend the theory portion from home. Course notes will be emailed on a weekly basis to marry in with the weekly tutorial.

The cost of the online six week course will be £75.00.

The course is “classroom-based” and does not include any practical elements working with hives. The course is designed to educate you on all the essential theory you need to begin.

The course will cover all aspects of beekeeping including the history, biology and lifecycle of the bee. It covers protective clothing, hive equipment and manipulation and the activities included in a typical beekeeping year.
